CURRICULUM

The curriculum consists of in-class presentations by City/County Managers, critiques of case studies, one-to-one coaching, small & large group activities, and action-planning.

NOTE: The first 2 sessions will be held remotely via Zoom and remaining sessions are tentatively planned for in-person with social distancing. Subject to change.
